A Band of Brothers—Reloaded

James 5:19-20

The Danger (19a)

James has repeatedly warned us of a very real danger in the church. There are many that claim to be believers; they participate in church life and activities; they would consider themselves Christians, but they are not.

The Rescue (19b)

We must be willing to confront others about their sin. We must not be content to let a professing believer turn from the faith.

The Victory (20)

What has this faithful brother accomplished? He has brought a brother back from the brink of death and judgment. The sinning brother has been rescued from the edge of hell, and his sins will be covered by God, who worked through the love of a brother.
